If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on observation that the divider door between the infant classroom and the two year old classroom was observed to be off the hinges. The consultant further observed the wall where the door was hanging to have splitting sheet rook and rotting wood.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the environment, the center will repair the door and the wall between the infant and two year old classroom.

Technical Assistance

The center has had a tree fall from a neighbor's yard on February 12, 2016. The director stated that the outdoor play area is not being used and is awaiting the adjuster to get pictures and make the repairs to the fencing. The director will notify the consultant once the tree has been removed and repairs to the fencing have been completed. The director will also send the consultant pictures once the outdoor play are is back operable. The consultant further discussed with the director that additional resilient surface needs to be added to the outdoor fall zones. The director will note that rusting on the seesaw equipment needs to be corrected as well. The children were not present on the outdoor play area on this date as the outdoor play area is not able to be in use.

Finding

591-1-1-.10(3)(a) requires that if diapers are changed on a diaper changing surface, the surface shall be smooth, nonporous, and equipped with a guard or rails to prevent falls. Between each diaper change, the diaper change surface shall be cleaned with a disinfectant and dried with a single-use disposable towel. It was determined based on observation that a staff was observed to not disinfect the diaper table after changing a child.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The director responsible person(s) will ensure there is a smooth, nonporous changing surface that has a guard or rails for safety in each classroom that houses children wearing diapers. The director will ensure Center Staff are trained and have adequate supplies to properly clean the diaper changing surface between each diaper change.

Finding

591-1-1-17(7)(a-d) requires that children wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids; after contamination by any other means. It was determined based on observation that a staff in the infant/one year old classroom was observed to not require children to complete hand washing after being diapered.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure proper handwashing by children, the director will ensure staff follow hand washing policies and procedures.
