Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.11(2)(c) requires that Center Staff shall not shake, jerk, pinch or handle a child roughly. It was determined based on staff statements that on February 16, 2017, a staff member in the two-year-old classroom was observed to yank children up by their arm, put them on the changing table to diaper them, then slam the children back down on their cots. The director stated this staff member no longer works at the facility.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The director will take immediate action to ensure the action has ceased; train/review appropriate child guidance techniques with center staff; and have a system in place to monitor and identify/prevent inappropriate actions.
