If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.10(1) requires Centers first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that are renovated after March 1, 1991, to provide ventilation in the diapering areas with functioning exhaust fans and a duct system or by the required operable windows. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that there is no working exhaust fan near the changing table and the screened windows are not opened during diapering.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The responsible person(s) at the center will ensure that the exhaust fans and duct systems are functioning or that the required amount of operable windows is provided in each diapering area.

Finding

591-1-1-17(7)(a-d) requires that children wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids; after contamination by any other means. Children were observed to not wash their hands as required. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the toddler teacher did not wash children hands after diapering and before returing the child to the play area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure proper handwashing by children, the center will be sure to wash children has after each diaper change and before returning to the play area.
