If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.25(3) requires that the Center and surrounding premises be clean, free of debris and in good repair. It was determined based on observation that the ceiling light did not have a cover over the light bulb in the right bathroom in classroom D, the girls and boys bathroom in classroom E, and the girls bathroom in classroom F. Additionally, the hot water was not working on the left hand washing sink in classroom E.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the environment, the center will replace the covers on the uncovered light bulbs.

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the edge of the platform of the small yellow slide on the school age playground was cracked.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will repair the crack in the platform.

591-1-1-.15(4) requires that feeding chairs meet the following requirements: 1) be cleaned with a disinfectant; 2) have a broad base to prevent tipping; 3) have a surface that the child cannot raise, 4) have a strap or other device which prevents the child from sliding out; and 5) have a feeding surface free of cracks. It was determined based on observation that 4 of 4 infants were sitting in feeding chairs and not strapped into the chairs.

It was determined based on observation that a one-year-old child was sleeping on a stuffed animal in the classroom floor instead of his assigned sleeping cot in classroom B.

The center will ensure that cots and mats are provided for each child who is two (2) years of age or older and who is required to take a nap. and for each child under the age of two years who can climb out of a crib.
