#### **Finding**

290-2-3-.13(2)(c) requires that outside play areas be protected from traffic or other hazards by fencing or other barriers at least four feet in height and approved by the Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children. A fence shall be provided around swimming pools to make them inaccessible when not in use. It was determined, based on Consultant observation, that the right-side middle section of the outdoor play area fence was not adequately sturdy and securely upright.
