It was determined based on the director statement, Pre-K staff statements and verbal interviews indicated that staff had knowledge of a five-year-old child being asked to clean a toilet with hazardous materials by a Pre-K staff member on February 20, 2020.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-1.11(1) requires that disciplinary actions used to correct a child's behavior, guidance techniques and any activities in which the children participate or observe at the Center shall not be detrimental to the physical or mental health of any child. It was determined based on the consultant interview and statement from the director, and the Pre-K staff statements and verbal interviews that staff had knowledge of five-year-old child asked to clean a toilet with hazardous materials by a Pre-K staff member on February 20, 2020.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Center staff will cease use of this disciplinary method; the director will provide staff training on appropriate child guidance techniques and have a system in place to monitor and identify/prevent inappropriate actions.
