If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be inaccessible to children. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that a bag of plant fertilizer, a box of rubber gloves and a roll of plastic garbage bags were being stored in a wood cabinet located on the left side of the door as you enter classroom B (2). The wood cabinet had a built in lock on the doors however this was not locked. Additionally, the consultant observed a box of rubber gloves were being stored in a wood cabinet located on the front right side of the wall in classroom A (1). The wood cabinet had a built in lock on the doors however this was not locked.

The center director will review the above policy with all staff who provides direct supervision to ensure that all hazards are stored away from and inaccessible to the children at all times.
