# 591-1-1-.25 Physical Plant - Safe Environment(CR)

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.25(12) requires that heating and cooling equipment be protected to prevent children from touching it. It was determined based on observation that children had access to a cooling unit located near the cribs in the far left side of the infant's classroom.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure that children's contact with the unit is prevented, the center will add a barrier for the cooling unit.

#### Finding

591-1-1-.25(3) requires that the Center and surrounding premises be clean, free of debris and in good repair. It was determined based on observation that the following areas/items were found to be noncompliant:

The right handwashing sink was observed to have very low water pressure in classroom 3R and classroom 5R. The handwashing sink adjacent to the bathroom and the handwashing sink near the non-diapering station was observed to have low water pressure for the hot water valve in classroom 1R.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the environment, the center will repair the noted items.

# 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)

#### **Technical Assistance**

Discussed-Fluff/Redistribute Surface to ensure that mats are completely flushed by the swings. Discussed isolated chipped paint on the red and green play structure on the school-age playground.

#### Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that to red trikes were observed to have handle grips missing. It was also determined that a potential hazard existed in that two salmon color scooters were observed to have torn grips, exposing sharp edges.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

591-1-1-.17(8)(a-d) requires staff to wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for the day, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after diapering each child, dispensing medication, applying topical medications, handling and preparing food, eating, drinking, preparing bottles, feeding each child, assisting children with eating and drinking, after toileting or assisting children with toileting, using tobacco products, handling garbage and organic waste, touching animals or pets, handling bodily fluids and after contamination by any means. It was determined based on observation that a staff member was observed to not wash their hands before diapering a child in the infant's classroom. The staff member was observed to use gloves. It was also determined based on observation that a staff member was observed to not wash their hands after wiping a child's nose.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure proper handwashing by staff, the center will train staff on proper handwashing.
