Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.18(4) makes the following dishwashing requirements for non-disposable dishes, glasses and silverware: 1) cleaned by pre-rinsing, or scraping, 2) washed, 3) sanitized and 4) air-dried. Center must either have a three compartment sink, or a dishwasher and a two-compartment sink. Dishes are to be sanitized by maintaining a temperature of 150 degrees in the rinse water or a sanitizing chemical must be used. It was determined on this date through the consultant's observation that a black mold like substance was underneath the lids on several sippy cups in rooms A and B. Several small black spots were observed on two pink cups underneath the two pink lids and an orange cup underneath the orange lid in the infant room. Several small black spots were observed underneath the lids of a blue cup with a blue lid, a green cup with a turquoise lid and an orange cup with a yellow lid. Several more widespread large black spots were observed on a blue cup with a blue lid in room B

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure proper dishwashing, the center will remove the lids and wash the cups or replace the cups.
