3) Specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, along with your concerns or questions regarding the rule citation

Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.15(3) requires that baby bottles and formula meet the following requirements: 1) be clearly labeled with the child's name; 2) parents will supply formula or breast milk daily in bottles and only the current day's formula or breast milk will be served; 3) bottles be refrigerated at 40 degrees Fahrenheit or less; and 4) only commercially prepared, ready to-feed formula be used if provided by the center. Refrigerated or frozen breast milk shall only be heated or thawed under warm, running water or in a container of warm water. It was determined based on observation that the formula provided for the center was powdered formula, ready-to-feed formula is required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure that baby bottles and formula meet all requirements, the center will provide commercially prepared, ready-to-feed formula.

A copy of the annual safety check will be kept in the Center or on the vehicle and should include evidence of any repairs and/or replacements that were identified as needed on the inspection report. It was determined based on review of records that the Center had an annual vehicle safety inspection on file that stated a tire needed to be replaced and the tire was not replaced.
