#### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.30(2)(a) requires Center Staff to place an infant to sleep on the infant's back in a crib unless the center has been provided a physician's written statement authorizing another sleep position for that particular infant that includes how the infant shall be placed to sleep and a time frame that the instructions are to be followed. During a complaint investigation it was determined that on the morning of February 22, 2017, a three month old child was not placed to sleep on it's back in a crib.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will ensure staff and parents has been trained on safe sleep polices.

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times. During a compliant investigation it was determined based on staff statements and interviews that on February 22, 2017 a three month old child was sleeping in a classroom without adult supervision.
