If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observations that several equipment hazards were present on this date. The plastic windshield of a red riding car was cracked in several areas. The seat was missing and wire was exposed on a Doc McStuffins riding toy. The plastic on the side of a large multicolor climber was cracked with sharp exposed edges. The front metal tire covering was rusted on one tricycyle. The side of an adult sized plastic chair was broken with sharp exposed plastic.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will remove the cited items. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

591-1-1-.17(8)(a-d) requires staff to wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for the day, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after diapering each child, dispensing medication, applying topical medications, handling and preparing food, eating, drinking, preparing bottles, feeding each child, assisting children with eating and drinking, after toileting or assisting children with toileting, using tobacco products, handling garbage and organic waste, touching animals or pets, handling bodily fluids and after contamination by any means. It was determined based on observation s that a staff member did not wash their hands after wiping a child's nose.
