(O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

The responsible person shall physically walk through the entire vehicle; visually inspect all seat surfaces, under all seats and in all compartments or recesses in the vehicle's interior; and sign the passenger transportation checklist(s), indicating all of the children have exited the vehicle. There shall be continuous watchful oversight of the vehicle between the first check and second check. It was determined based on the consultant's review of records that on February 16, 2018 for the morning route the center did not document the second check from the route from Taylor's Creek Elementary School. It was further determined based on the consultant's review of records that on February 23, 2018 that the center did not document second check for the afternoon route from Smiley Elementary School. It was further determined based on the consultant's review of records that on March 2, 2018, the center did not document second check for the morning route from Frank Long Elementary School.

The Center will train Staff who are or may be involved in transporting children in how to thoroughly inspect a vehicle and properly complete transportation documentation. The Center will review and monitor.
