Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on staff statements that mold was discovered in the center's windows.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring. The director has already had the windows cleaned. The center has been in contact with the company that installed the windows and plans to have the windows replaced. The center will also monitor the windows to maintain that the mold does not return.
