Finding

591-1-1-.26(7) requires that a resilient surface be provided and maintained beneath the fall zone of climbing and swinging equipment. It was determined based on consultant's observation of the center's playground area there was zero inches to two inches of resilient surface material beneath the fall zones of the swings, slides, climbing equipment. Additional mulch was present at the center but had not been placed on the playground.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the adequacy of a protective surface beneath climbing and swinging equipment, the center will add six inches of resilient surface. For equipment five feet high and over, including swings, six inches of resilient material is recommended and three inches of resilient material is recommended for equipment less than five feet high.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on consultant's observation of the center's playground area that a potential tripping hazard was observed in that consultant observed exposed black tarp on the front right side of the dome shaped jungle gym.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will remove and/or cover the black tarp with the resilient surface on the playground.
