It was determined based on consultant observation that the following outside toys posed a hazard to children in care: -blue and yellow rocker had a crack with sharp edges on the handle

-green rocker was observed to have no handles

-black and orange three wheel riding toy was observed to have a broken seat

-purple four wheeler was observed to have no seat

It was further determined that the outside toys were in need of being cleaned.
