If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation that unsafe storage of materials dangerous to children was observed in Room B in that there was Vaseline stored in a cubby accessible to children that was labeled "Keep out of reach of Children."

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the center will ensure to check cubbies for hazards.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(7) requires that climbing and swinging equipment be anchored and have a resilient surface beneath the equipment. The fall-zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on observation that on the front play the following had adequate resilient surface:

- -Swings set: approximately one to two inches in depth
- -Red and Blue Slide: approximately one inch

Six inch of resilient surface was needed for both.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will develop and/or follow a plan for routine inspections of the resilient surface and for replacing when needed.
