591-1-1-.25(3) requires that the Center and surrounding premises be clean, free of debris and in good repair. It was determined based on consultant's investigative findings the following item was found to be noncompliant: a drawer located on the back left side of classroom thirteen next to the restroom was observed to be broken on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the environment, the center will repair the drawer in classroom thirteen.

591-1-1-.10 Diapering Areas & Practices(CR)

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.10(1) requires Centers first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that are renovated after March 1, 1991, to provide ventilation in the diapering areas with functioning exhaust fans and a duct system or by the required operable windows. It was determined based on consultant's investigative findings the ventilation in classroom ten and classroom thirteen was observed to be inoperable on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The responsible person(s) at the center will ensure that the exhaust fans and duct systems are functioning or that the required amount of operable windows is provided in each diapering area.
