Before a change of occupant, each mattress shall be cleaned with a disinfectant. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that 4 of 8 crib mattresses were not tight- fitting without gaps on this date. It was further determined based on the consultant's observation that 2 of 8 mattress were not at least two inches thick.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will ensure that a crib mattress is firm, tight-fitting without gaps, at least, and purchase new mattress that are at least 2 inches thick.
