If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on the consultant's request to review the satisfactory comprehensive background check determination letter for a recently hired staff member that there was no evidence of a background check determination of any type. A search of the Bright From the Start internal system for background check determinations was also searched with no results. The staff member was observed to be present during the day of the visit.

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION - The Home will ensure that every actual and potential Provider, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Family Child Care Learning Home submit both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site as required. The provider must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The Home will ensure the CRC rules are maintained. The staff member will not return to the FCCLH until a satisfactory Comprehensive Criminal Background check has been received.
