591-1-1-.12(2)(a) requires that equipment and furniture be free from hazardous conditions such as, but not limited to, sharp rough edges or toxic paint. It was determined based on the consultant's observation that the black cardboard along the bottom and right side of the race track is peeling and pulling away from the track and is accessible to all children within classroom B. Additionally, the blue cushion on the rocking chair located in classroom A is ripped on the left side of the bottom cushion and foam is accessible to all children within the classroom.

The center director will develop/implement a system for informing center staff about identification of hazards and what to do when a hazard is identified.
