If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that the gate leading to the parking lot on the right-side of the playground was no longer attached at the top hinges.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.

Children were not supervised in that it was determined based on observation that there was no staff watching the two and three-year-old children and the door was closed on this date. Further, the staff member in the infant room had to leave an infant unattended on several occasions to get the door and go up to the office. Further, children were left unsupervised in classroom C while staff had to go into the kitchen, attached to this room, to prepare lunch.

The center will provide training to staff and monitor to ensure that children are supervised at all times.
