3) Specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, along with your concerns or questions regarding the rule citation

Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.20(3) requires the Center to maintain a record of medication dispensed that includes the date, time and amount of medication, any noticeable adverse reaction, and the signature or initials of the person administering the medication. It was determined based on consultant observation that medication was due to be given from February 22, 2017 until March 8, 2017. Based on the medication log the medication was only given on February 22, 2017, and not the other listed dates. It was further determined that the medication prescription number was listed on the log, but no medication name.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure completion of medication records, the center will ensure that the names, prescription number are on the authorization. In addition the center will give the medication on all listed dates, or not the child did not bring the mediation, or was absent on the days.
