If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

Finding

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on consultant's observation that the windows in classroom A had three broken glass panes. The left window had one (1) broken glass pane in the bottom left corner and the right window had two (2) broken glass panes on the top half of the window.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will order and replace the broken glass panes.

It was determined based on observation that the center did not make substitution to the menu posted. The posted menu listed noodles, ground beef, carrots, and milk. The menu served consisted of carrots, green beans, nuggets, and bread.

The Center will list all of the current week's meals and snacks and all substitutions on the menu and keep past menus on file for six months and will implement a system to monitor this.

It was determined based on consultant observation that two (2) of eight (8) employees did not have evidence of a satisfactory records check determination before being present at the center.

The Center will obtain the Required Satisfactory Records Check Determination before an individual is present at the Center while any child is present for care or before residing in a Center.

591-1-1-.31(2)(b)6. requires the Center to ensure the teachers/lead caregivers provide an oral or written statement, as requested by the Department, that they have not abused, neglected or deprived a child or adult or subjected any person to serious injury as a result of intentional or grossly negligent misconduct. It was determined based on consultant review of staff records that one person did not have credentials as required to perform as the lead teacher in class room (D) with the three (3) year olds.
