If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.20(4) requires the Center to keep medication in a locked cabinet or container that is not accessible to children and stored separate from cleaning chemicals, supplies or poisons. Medication requiring refrigeration shall be placed in a leak-proof container in a refrigerator that is not accessible to the children. It was determined based on observation that prescription liquid syrup (Brumfed) and Motrin were observed in a child's diaper bag that was accessible to children in the three-year-old to school-age classroom. The consultant further observed Tylenol and A&D Ointment to be in a child's diaper bag sitting on the table in the infant to one-year-old classroom.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff on the safe and proper storage of medication and monitor to ensure that the rule is met.
