290-2-3-.13(2)(a) requires that outdoor play areas be kept clean and free of hazards such as exposed sharp corners of concrete or equipment, rust and splinters on equipment, broken glass, open drainage ditches, holes and stagnant water. It was determined based on observation that on the porch area which was observed in use, children had access to a propane tank and a grill. Further, a yellow tricycle was observed to be missing pedals.
