The center has made the swing inaccessible until the fall zone can be extended. Please ensure that the resilient material is a least six inches in depth at all times throughout the fall zone.

Discussed adding cones to the right side of the large playground to ensure children will not go to the area. The teacher will ensure to position themselves to monitor the entire licensed playground area.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on observation, several potential hazards were observed in the outdoor play area. The Consultant observed the following items to be potential hazards.

- --English Ivy and weeds were observed growing through the fence near the back on the large playground.
- --Gaps on the stairs outside of Classroom D measured between five and one half inches to six inches.
- --Exposed tree roots were observed near the fence on left side of the large playground.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will use the playground maintenance checklist to assist center personnel in routine inspections of playground fencing equipment, anchoring, surface and hazardous items.

It was determined based on observation, there was no functioning ventilation in the diapering areas. The exhaust fan would not come on and the windows would not open on this date.
