It was determined based on observation that children under three years old were combined with older children at a time other than arrival/departure.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will maintain separation of these children under three years old.

Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(4) requires that children under three years old be housed in separate physical areas from older children except during early morning arrival and late afternoon departure times. It was determined based on staff statements, and consultant's observation, there is enough evidence to substantiate the allegation stating that the center staff has been responsible for children of mixed ages, ranging from two-years-old to ten-year-old or older on a regular basis.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will maintain separation of these children under three years old.
