#### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.25(9) requires that the Center not allow a person to remain on the premises if the person does not have a legitimate reason for being on the premises. The Center did not take action to remove a person who did not have a legitimate reason for being on the premises. It was determined, based on investigation, that multiple individuals, including family members and friends some of whom have children enrolled at the Center, were present on multiple dates without a legitimate reason for being on the premises.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure that only persons with a legitimate reason remain on the premises, the center will ensure only staff, contractors, maintenance staff, parents, and release designees are present at the facility when children are present.
