If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding 591-1-132(2) requires the Center maintain Staff:child ratios in mixed-age groups based on the age of the youngest group of children that includes more than twenty percent of the total number of children in the mixed-age group. It was determined based on observation that there was a ratio of 2:52 in the cafeteria upon the consultant's arrival. The group included five five-year-old children and children ages six years and older. Based on the number and ages of children present, the required ratio was 3:52. In addition, ratio requirements were not compliant several times during the visit for this same group of children. A ratio of 1:44 was observed at 3:20 PM when a staff member took a group of children to the rest room and two staff persons were required at the time. A ratio of 2:57 was observed at 3:26 PM and three staff persons were required. A ratio of 1:37 was observed at 3:36 PM when a staff member took another group of children to the restroom and two staff persons were required.
