If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation the that disinfectant wipes were observed to be sitting on a toy shelf in the first right classroom. The consultant further observed an employee purse/bag which had advil medication accessible to children in the third left classroom.

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the center will ensure hazards are stored inaccessible to children at all times.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on observation that wood surrounding the climbing equipment was observed to be rotten and broken which resulting in splintering wood being exposed to children on the large left side outdoor play area. The consultant further observed broken tree limbs and sticks to be accessible to children on the rear outdoor play area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will ensure that any wood that is rotten and hazardous is replaced. The center will further ensure that maintenance of the outdoor play areas are maintained.
