Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. It was determined based on observation that two playground with swing sets had inadequate amount or resilient surfacing beneath and around the swings.

The Center will develop and/or follow a plan for routine inspections of the resilient surface and for replacing when needed.

Finding

591-1-1-17(7)(a-d) requires that children wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for care, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after eating meals and snacks, handling or touching food, playing in water; after toileting and diapering, playing in sand, touching animals or pets, and contact with bodily fluids; after contamination by any other means. It was determined based on observation that a child was diapered in the first left room and his hands were not washed afterwards.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure proper handwashing by children, the center will ensure staff are washing children hands after they finish diapering children.

Finding

591-1-1-.17(8)(a-d) requires staff to wash their hands with liquid soap and warm running water upon arrival for the day, when moving from one child care group to another, upon re-entering the child care area after outside play, before and after diapering each child, dispensing medication, applying topical medications, handling and preparing food, eating, drinking, preparing bottles, feeding each child, assisting children with eating and drinking, after toileting or assisting children with toileting, using tobacco products, handling garbage and organic waste, touching animals or pets, handling bodily fluids and after contamination by any means. It was determined based on observation that a staff member changed their gloves after diapering a child but did not wash them afterwards and before diapering the next child.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure proper handwashing by staff, the center will ensure staff wash their hands before and after diaper changes prior to putting on gloves.
