If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Staffing and Supervision

591-1-1-.32 Staff:Child Ratios and Group Size(CR)

Finding

591-1-1-.32(2) requires the Center maintain Staff:child ratios in mixed-age groups based on the age of the youngest group of children that includes more than twenty percent of the total number of children in the mixed-age group. It was determined, based on observation, that a ratio of 3:101 was observed with children that were five years of age and older, when a ratio of 6:101 was required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure adequate Staff:child ratios in mixed age groups. The Center will hire additional staff or adjust staff arrival times to maintain ratios.

591-1-1-.32 **Supervision(CR)**

Not Met

Finding

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times. It was determined, based on observation, that children were not supervised in that two children were observed to enter the hallway briefly without adult supervision. It was further determined, that a child was observed to enter into the gym briefly without adult supervision, while the remaining children and staff were on the playground.

The center will provide training to staff and monitor to ensure that children are supervised at all times.
