If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. #### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that both gates to the playground on the left and right side of the house were left open on this date.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will routinely check the fence to determine if it is in good repair and remains at least 4 feet high, and will repair any hazards. The Center will train Staff to identify and report any fence hazards and to keep the fence gates closed when not in use.

Correction Deadline: 5/15/2017

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(7) requires that climbing and swinging equipment be anchored and have a resilient surface beneath the equipment. The fall-zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resilient. It was determined based on observation that the yellow swing did not have an adequate amount of resilient surfacing in the fall zones.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will ensure that climbing and swinging equipment is anchored. The Center will develop and/or follow a plan for routine inspections of the resilient surface and for replacing when needed.

Correction Deadline: 5/25/2017

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on observation that the pink and purple Little Tikes structure had mildew covering the structure and that the orange mesh construction barrier was not secured and presented a tripping hazard in the outdoor play area.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will remove, replace or repair all hazards.

#### 591-1-1-.32 Staff: Child Ratios and Group Size(CR)

**Not Met** 

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.32(3)(a) requires the Center to maintain Staff-child ratios in mixed-age groups of children under three years old based on the age of the youngest child under three years of age. It was determined based on observation that one staff member was present with twelve children, all under three years old, and three of the children present were infants.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

To ensure adequate Staff:child ratios for groups of children three years and younger are met the Center will obtain more staff to maintain adequate ratios.

#### 591-1-1-.32 Supervision(CR)

**Not Met** 

#### **Finding**

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times. Children were not supervised in that three sleeping infants were left in a separate area with no supervision.

The center will provide training to staff and monitor to ensure that children are supervised at all times.
