### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined based on an incident investigation, that on May 15, 2019, a one-year-old child was observed to be holding and chewing on a cigarette lighter. There were no injuries reported due to this incident.

### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.
