This Monitoring Visit is the second regulatory visit for Bullfrogs & Butterflies Child Care Learning Center this 2016 - 2017 fiscal year.

The consultant reviewed all staff files and finds a satisfactory fingerprint criminal records clearance determination letter on file for each employee. The consultant discussed with the center director that comprehensive fingerprint criminal records checks are due on all employees by October 1, 2017.

The consultant discussed SIDS / Safe Sleep with the infant staff and center director.

Any rule violation which subjects a child to injury or life-threatening situation or any rule violations previously cited but not corrected, may result in the imposition of an adverse enforcement action. Serious or continued noncompliance may also jeopardize participation in one or more DECAL program(s).

3) Specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, along with your concerns or questions regarding the rule citation

Refutations must be submitted to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)
