If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Your program must be Quality Rated by December 31, 2020 in order to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Sign up for Quality Rated by June 30, 2018 in order to be eligible to receive a bonus package.

The director will have the center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris. Director will ensure that the sink in the Pre-K classroom (4) is repaired at the bottom. The sink has a whole at the bottom left near the baseboard with debris in it. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring.

The previous citation has been corrected on this date. The consultant observed the bottom and the top gate on the first left playground to be two inches or less.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(6) requires that playground equipment provide an opportunity for the children to engage in a variety of experiences and shall be age-appropriate. For example, toddlers shall not be permitted to swing in swings designed for School-age Children. The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based upon consultant's observation, that the orange slide on the toddler playground, located on the left side of the building had a crack on the side on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will provide a variety of age-appropriate equipment that is arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. Staff will check the equipment daily to ensure that the equipment is free of hazards, rust and splinters.

Correction Deadline: 6/6/2018

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on consultant's observation that turf near two yellow slides were broken apart and split on the first right side playground causing a potential tripping hazard for children.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove hazards. The director stated that a maintenance request will be submitted on this date.
