Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on investigative findings which included interviews, statements, and supporting documents, that on May 1, 2018, children were not adequately supervised when a one-year-old child sustained first and second degree burns on her feet after she was allowed to be barefoot on the playground for an undetermined amount of time.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
