Bright from the Start recommends that all licensed child care providers carry liability insurance coverage sufficient to protect its clients. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

Finding

591-1-1-.14(1) requires the Center Director to successfully complete a biennial training program in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) and a triennial training program in first aid that is conducted by certified or licensed health care professionals and deals with the provision of emergency care to infants and children. In addition, at least fifty percent (50%) of the caregiver Staff shall have completed such training at any given time. It was determined based on consultant's review of staff files the center had less than 50 percent of their staff members certified in first aid and CPR training. The center is required to have four staff members certified, but the consultant only observed three staff members to be certified on this date.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

Per the director, the center has first aid and CPR training scheduled for June 5, 2017. The Center director and at least 50% of the caregiver Staff will complete the needed training. The director will send written verification to the consultant upon completion and will develop a plan to ensure that at least 50% of the caregiver Staff have completed this training at any given time.
