Finding Associated with Complaint

591-1-1-.03(3)(e) requires center staff to refrain from engaging in, or allowing children or other adults to engage in, activities that could be detrimental to a child's health or wellbeing, such as but not limited to, horse play, rough play, wrestling, and picking up a child in a manner that could cause injury. It was determined based on a complaint investigation that on June 1, 2017 center staff did not physically intervene when two children walked up and hit a three-year-old child in the back.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will review requirements with staff to ensure that appropriate activities are conducted with children.
