#### **Finding Associated with Complaint**

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on an investigation that on May 13, 2020, at 9:15 a.m. a ceiling fan fell in classroom B. The fan grazed a one-year-old child's head which resulted in the child sustaining a bump behind the ear on the left side. The child received professional medical attention.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will implement a plan to keep areas clean and in good repair that includes regular monitoring. The center discarded the ceiling fan on May 13, 2020.
