591-1-1-.11(2)(c) requires that Center Staff shall not shake, jerk, pinch or handle a child roughly.

It was determined that on May 2, 2017, a five-year-old child sustained red marks around her wrist when a staff person held her hand, while redirecting her. The child was resisting and attempted to pull away. The child claimed that the staff person was hurting her hand. The staff person briefly held the child by the wrist to readjust his method of hand holding. This resulted in red marks around the child's wrist. The child did not require professional medical treatment.
