If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.12(1)(b) requires center staff to use all indoor and outdoor furniture, activity materials, and equipment in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions, recommendations, and intended use. It was determined based on observation that staff failed to use the safety straps in the feeding chairs with 7 of 8 children that were seated in feeding chairs during the visit.

Staff will use the safety straps with all children that are seated in feeding chairs.

The driver or other designated staff person shall document in writing with a different mark/symbol to account for each child listed on the passenger transportation checklist who was not present on the vehicle for any reason. An explanation shall be documented in writing whenever a child is transported to a field trip site but is not present on the return trip to the Center. It was determined based on a review of records that the center had one transportation form for the week of May 8-12, 2017, without a mark or symbol to account for the unloading of seven children on the afternoon bus route for May 9, 2017.

The driver/other designated person will immediately document in writing with a check/mark/symbol each time a child gets on and off the vehicle.
