## Finding

591-1-1-.32(7) requires that children be supervised at all times and that the persons supervising in the child care area be alert, able to respond promptly to the needs and actions of the children being supervised, as well as the actions of the chaperones and Students-in-Training, and provide timely attention to the children's actions and needs. It was determined based on consultant's observation that a staff member briefly walked out of a supervised area of the classroom to attend to a child washing their hands in the restroom leaving four children in care in the classroom not supervised.

The Center will train Staff and monitor to ensure they are providing supervision and watchful oversight to the children at all times.
