Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that two sections of fence to the right of the locked shed had exposed sharp and rusted edges. Additionally, the gate was observed to be open and not closed as required.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The center will repair using a board at the bottom of the fence or replace the fence sections that have sharp edges. The center will monitor the fence regularly and make any additional repairs as needed. The center will ensure the gate is closed at all times.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that the following hazards were accessible to children:

- -The pink and blue little tykes coupe was missing the gas cap and the eyes on the front of the coupe were broken and had sharp edges.
- -Under the outdoor sink trash consisting of juice cups had been left out overnight and the trash can had been tipped over causing trash to spill out.
- -On the grill/patio play set the two white fence pieces had pulled out and a screw was exposed on both sides of the play set.
- -Under the outdoor sink there was a wooden board with two exposed nails.
- -Two mops were left outside on the deck leading to the playground.
- -Two broken hula hoops with sharp edges where they are bent were on the playground.

During the visit the director removed the board and cozy coupe from the play area and cleaned up the trash.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
