**Finding**

591-1-1-.25(11) requires that floor coverings be tight, smooth, free of odors and washable or cleanable. It was determined based on consultant's observation that the base board in the bathroom was loose and coming off the wall around the toilet in the boys bathroom.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The center will secure the base board around the toilet.

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**591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR)****Not Met****Finding**

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined by consultant's observation that hazards existed, rust was observed on the gate poles, and four (4) bolts were protruding more than two (2) threads around the entrance gate. .

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Center will treat the rust and repaint the gate, and cut down the bolts and smooth off edges. The center will complete a playground check on a regular basis.

**Correction Deadline: 7/28/2017****Finding**

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on consultant's observation that hazards existed in that there were exposed tree roots at the bottom of top left.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Center will paint the exposed tree roots. The center will routinely check the playground on a regular basis.

591-1-1-.10(1) requires Centers first licensed after March 1, 1991, and Centers that are renovated after March 1, 1991, to provide ventilation in the diapering areas with functioning exhaust fans and a duct system or by the required amount of window space provided by operable windows when open. It was determined based on consultant's observation that there was no ventilation or adequate window space available in the classroom.

**POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The center will install a ventilation system to ensure compliance.
