If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined, based on observation, that hazards were observed as follows:

- -In Room EPK 1: Adult scissors and a tape dispenser were observed in an unlocked file cabinet and was accessible to children in care.
- -In Room EPK 2: A bottle of sunscreen was observed on the floor near the cubbies and a bottle of lotion and Vaseline were observed on a cabinet accessible to children in care.
- -In Room GPK: A container of deodorant was observed in a child's bag and was accessible to children in care.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.
