If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. Finding

290-2-3-.11(2)(f) requires that poisons, medicines, cleaning agents and other hazardous materials be in locked areas or inaccessible to children. It was determined based on observation that the two drawers on the left and one on the right in the bathroom was observed to be unlocked and contained hairspray, nail polish, skin cream and make up accessible to the children in care. It was also determined that the drawer near the dishwasher and the first draw on the island was observed to be unlocked and contained scissors and knives that were accessible to the children in care.

To ensure the safe storage of hazardous items, the Home Provider will make these items inaccessible to the children.
