It was determined based on observation that the school-age classroom (1L) was observed to provide care for 38 children in a classroom that had a capacity of 26 children.

The Center will limit the number of children in this space to the licensed capacity.

## **Finding**

591-1-1-.25(3) requires the Center and surrounding premises to be kept clean, free of debris and in good repair. Hygienic measures such as, but not limited to, screened windows and proper waste disposal procedures shall be utilized to minimize the presence of rodents, flies, roaches and other vermin at the Center. It was determined based on observation that one of two toilets were observed to be inoperable in the back classroom. The consultant further observed paint to be peeling in the two-year-old (2L) classroom near the play kitchen area.

## POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will have the Center and surrounding areas cleaned, make repairs where needed, and remove all debris is removed. The Center will have the toilet repaired and ensure no paint is peeling off walls.
