)591-1-1-.10(5) requires that center staff shall not leave infants or children unattended while being diapered or having their clothes changed on the diaper changing surface. It was determined based on an investigation that a six-month-old child was left unattended on the diaper changing table on June 30, 2017, when the child sustained second degree burns to the right leg when the child's leg went under hot running water while the staff member obtained the child's bottle from the refrigerator adjacent to the diaper changing table.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

A plan of improvement is due by August 16, 2017.
